A. People often ask where exactly was Anne Boleyn executed at the Tower of London and where exactly was she imprisoned. It's good to know these facts when you go to the Tower of London because you can look for these places and pause for a moment and think of Anne and her story.



B. The enormous London Eye is difficult to miss. It towers above Westminster and the Houses of Parliament giving you a fantastic bird's eye view over all of London. The ride takes 30 minutes, and carries you up to a height of 135 metres .



C. Tower Bridge crosses the Thames from the Tower of London in the north to Shad Thames on the South Bank. You can walk or drive across it, but for the best views, visit the exhibition to access the high level walkways.



D. One of the best things about the approach of winter is that it heralds the return of London 's ice rinks. Positioned directly beside the London Eye and facing the Thames, this is one of the best-located rinks in the city.
